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## **SBA and the IRS Present: Understanding the Affordable Care Act Small Business Healthcare Tax Credit**

***Free Seminar Offered on Tax Credit That Helps Small Businesses Afford the Cost Of Covering Their Employees***

The Alabama District Office of the US Small Business Administration will host a seminar on the Small Business Healthcare Tax Credit provisions of the Affordable Care Act on Thursday April 7, 2016, from 9:00 – 11:30 am. The seminar will be held at the SBA District Office, 801 Tom Martin Drive, Suite 201, Birmingham 35211 in the second floor Training Room.

IRS Senior Stakeholder Nora Huffman will discuss the Small Business Health Care Tax Credit, Online Tax Calendar and Direct Pay. The Local Taxpayer Advocate will also be in attendance to provide information related to Taxpayer Advocacy services.

The Small Business Health Care Tax Credit helps small businesses and small tax-exempt organizations afford the cost of covering their employees, and is specifically targeted for those with low- and moderate-income workers. The credit is designed to encourage small employers to offer health insurance coverage for the first time or maintain coverage they already have. In general, the credit is available to small employers that pay at least half the cost of single coverage for their employees.
