Lessons from the National Single Audit Sampling Project

Description: The National Single Audit Quality Project provided the only statistically selected evidence of the quality of single audits performed by CPAs. It resulted in a series of findings that signal trouble for those who perform, review and rely on single audits of entities who expend federal awards. This course is a review of the significant findings that resulted from the study and a review of the applicable single audit standards to provide practitioners with the tools necessary to avoid making similar mistakes in the audits of federal programs.
